

Summer 2000 Graduation Profile

Points of Interest

- ❖ The Summer graduating class of 2000 consisted of 256 graduates: 134 were bachelors, 120 were masters, and 2 were doctorates.
- ❖ Of the 256 graduates, 223 were from Texas, 1 was from another state, and 32 were from other countries when they entered the University.
- ❖ The most frequent county of origin of graduates was Kleberg (43), followed by Bexar (35), Nueces (31), Jim Wells, (23), Hidalgo (12), and Cameron (11).
- ❖ Of the graduating class, one hundred and fifty-seven (61.3%) were minority students. Ninety-eight (73.1%) of the bachelors, fifty-seven (47.5%) of the masters, and both (100.0%) doctorates were minority students.
- ❖ Of the graduating class, 134 (52.3%) were female. Sixty-three (47.0%) of the bachelors, sixty-nine (57.5%) of the masters, and both (100.0%) doctorates were female.
- ❖ Of the 134 bachelors graduates, 75 (55.9%) entered the University as first time freshmen and 59 (44.4%) entered as transfer students. Of the 74 first time freshmen, 32 (42.7%) took at least one remediation course.
- ❖ Average age of bachelors was 27.7 years (min 21, max 56)
- ❖ Average age of masters was 35.3 years (min 23, max 55)
- ❖ Average age of doctorates was 53.3 years (min 41, max 65)
