

**Profile of Summer 1996 Graduating Class
Texas A&M University-Kingsville**

The summer graduating class of 1996 consisted of 216 graduates, 122 were bachelors, 90 were masters, and 4 were doctorates.

Of the 216 graduates, 196 were from Texas, 4 were from other states and 16 listed international permanent addresses.

The most frequent county of origin of graduates was Bexar (39), followed by Kleberg (29), Nueces (21), Jim Wells (20), and Cameron county (11). #

One hundred and twenty one (56%) of the total graduates were minority students. Sixty four percent of the bachelors graduates and 75% of the doctoral graduates were minority students.

One hundred and fourteen (53%) of the total graduates were female. Fifty seven percent of the masters students were female. All 4 of the Doctoral students were female.

Of the 122 bachelors graduates, 69 were first time freshman (FTF) and 53 were transfer students.
Of the 69 FTF, 35 (51%) took at least one remediation course

Average time to graduation for first time freshman students was 6.5 years(min 3.25, max 16.25*)
Average time to graduation for transfer students was 4.1 years(min 1.25, max 16.25*)

Average age of bachelor graduates was 26.5 years(min 21, max 48)

Average age of master graduates was 34.7 years(min 23, max 57)

Average age of doctoral graduates was 38.8 years(min 32, max 48)

Average GPA for bachelors graduates was 2.8 (min 2.1, max 3.97)

Average GPA for masters graduates was 3.78 (min 3.1, max 4.00)

Considering Patronymic suffixes there were 11 Jrs., 3 IIIs and 1 Sr.
