

Fall 1998 Graduation Profile

Points of Interest

- ✍ The Fall graduating class of 1998 consisted of 334 graduates: 245 were bachelors, 85 were masters, and 4 were doctorates.
- ✍ Of the 334 graduates, 302 were from Texas, 3 were from other states, and 29 were from other countries when they entered the University.
- ✍ The most frequent county of origin of graduates was Nueces (49) followed by Kleberg (48), Bexar (28), Jim Wells (25), and Cameron (24).
- ✍ Of the graduating class, two hundred and eight (62%) were minority students. One hundred and seventy-one (70%) of the bachelors, thirty-six (42.2%) of the masters, and one (25%) of the doctorates were minority students.
- ✍ Of the graduating class, one hundred and twenty (49%) were female. One hundred and twenty (49%) of the bachelors, forty-one (48%) of the masters, and three (75%) of the doctorates were female.
- ✍ Of the 245 bachelors graduates, 141(58%) entered the University as first time freshmen and 104 (42%) entered as transfer students. Of the 141 first time freshmen, 71 (50%) took at least one remediation course.
- ✍ Of the graduating class, 4 were full-time employees of the university.
- ✍ Average age of bachelors was 27.5 years (min 21, max 59)
- ✍ Average age of masters was 35.2 years (min 24, max 55)
- ✍ Average age of doctorates was 40.5 years (min 27, max 61)
