

Spring 1998 Graduation Profile

Points of Interest

- The Spring graduating class of 1998 consisted of 428* graduates, 301 were bachelors, 115 were masters, and 12 were doctorates. This was the largest graduating class in twenty years.
- *Three undergraduate students in the College of Arts and Science were added after the remaining sections of this report were generated.
- Of the 425 graduates, 385 were from Texas, 7 were from other states, and 33 were from other countries when they entered the University.
- The most frequent county of origin of graduates was Nueces (79), followed by Kleberg (53), Bexar (35), Cameron (31), and Jim Wells county (28).
- Two hundred and sixty five (62%) of the graduates were minority students. Two hundred and eleven (71%) of the bachelors, forty seven (41%) of the masters, and seven (58%) of the doctorates were minority students.
- Two hundred and thirteen (50%) of the graduates were female. One hundred and forty one (47%) of the bachelors, sixty two (54%) of the masters, and ten (83%) of the doctorates were female.
- Of the 298 bachelors graduates, 169 (57%) entered the University as first time freshmen and 129 (43%) entered as transfer students. Of the 169 first time freshmen, 67 (40%) took at least one remediation course.
- Average age of bachelors was 26.5 years (min 21, max 59)
- Average age of masters was 33.7 years (min 24, max 68)
- Average age of doctorates was 43.9 years (min 29, max 53)
